HOUSE RULES

- Pets are welcome in the facility (maximum 2 per apartment) with an extra €20 per pet per stay;
- To protect your animals, it is forbidden to leave them unattended inside the apartment.



PETS

BASIC SUPPLY



The basic supply (toilet paper, shampoo, shower gel, etc.) is provided by the structure. Once finished, the guest will have to take care of the repurchase.

- Separate waste collection is mandatory;
- Garbage must be thrown into the appropriate buckets in the common courtyard;
- For any doubts contact us.



GARBAGE

INFORMATIONS

- Fill the container with water;
- Connect to the mains;
- Turn on rear switch;
- Insert the pod and press the lever until it clicks;
- When the switch turns solid green, press to release the coffee;
- Throw the pod into the wet waste.

- On the first floor in the wardrobe outside the Perla apartment.

The pods are provided based on the number of guests and days of stay. Additional pods cost €0.50 each.

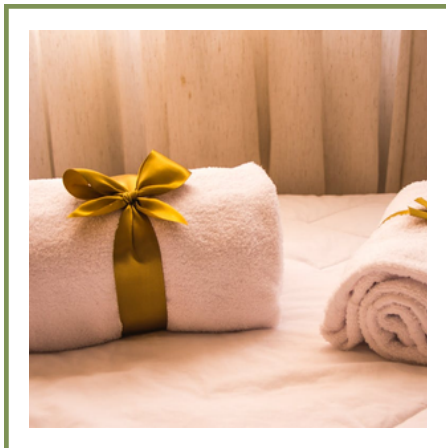
We offer a variety of coffee pods (decaffeinated, barley etc.).

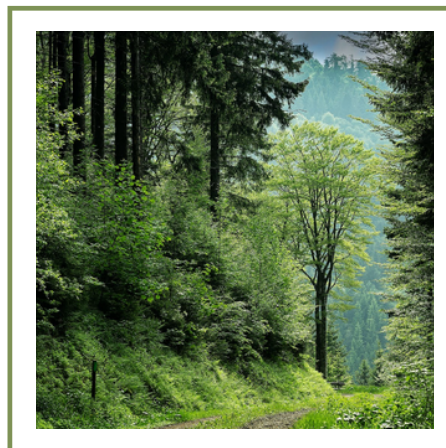
TOWELS AND SHEETS



Towels are changed free of charge mid-week for stays of at least 7 nights and sheets are changed every 7 days for stays longer than a week.

Upon request we offer a change of towels and sheets with an extra €10 per person.

- Do the separate waste collection correctly;
- The temperature of air conditioners in summer must be set to a maximum of 27 °C (80 °F);
- The temperature of the radiators in winter must be set at maximum 19 °C (66 °F);
- Do not leave windows open with the air conditioner/radiator turned on;
- Due to a water emergency, use water sparingly.

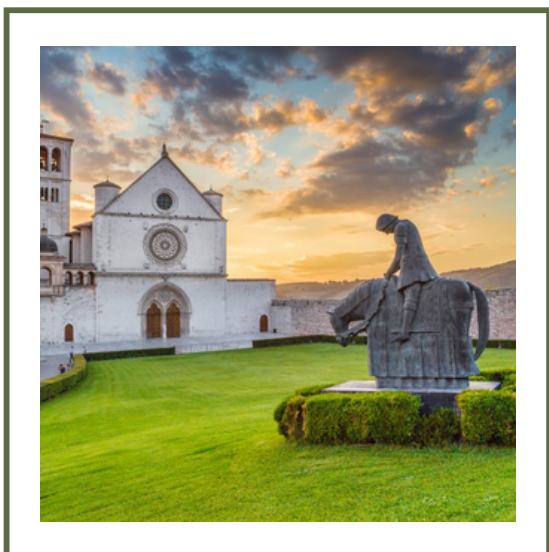
GROCERY SHOP IN THE HISTORIC CENTER

PERUGIA

How to get there: by car, park at the Saba Piazza Partigiani car park and then take the escalators to the historic centre.

By train, Perugia Fontivegge stop then take the minimetro to the Pincetto stop.

To see: Rocca Paolina, Etruscan Well, National Gallery, Fontana Maggiore, Palazzo dei Priori, Abbey of San Pietro, Etruscan Arch, Aqueduct ladders.



ASSISI

How to get there: by car, park at the Majana car park, exit on the top floor and arrive at the basilicas of S. Francesco and S. Chiara.

By train, get off at Assisi and take the bus to P. Matteotti.

To see: Basilica S. Francesco, Basilica S. Chiara, Cathedral S. Ruffino, Rocca Maggiore, Church S. Damiano, Eremo delle Carceri, Bosco di S. Francesco.

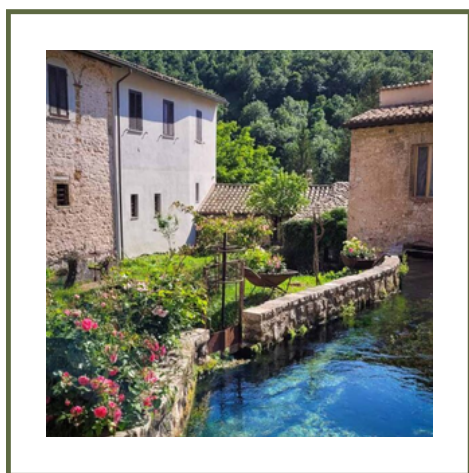
NEAR SPELLO

SPOLETO

How to get there: by car, park at the Posterna or Ponzianina car park and take the escalators to the centre.

By train, Spoleto stop then take the Ponzianina escalators to the centre.

To see: Rocca Albornoziana, Spoleto Cathedral, Ponte delle Torri, Roman Theatre, Basilica of S. Salvatore, Germanico Art Gallery, Piazza del Duomo.

NATURAL ATTRACTIVEIONS

The Piani di Castelluccio located within the Sibillini Mountains National Park are a karst-alluvial plateau of the Umbria-Marche Apennines. Located at approximately 1,350 m above sea level, famous for flowering in early summer.



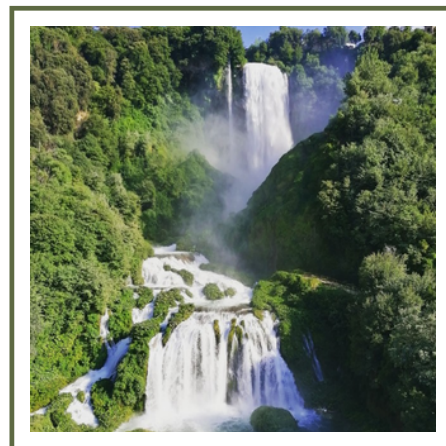
SIBILLINI MOUNTAINS NATIONAL PARK AND CASTELLUCCIO DI NORCIA

MONTE CUCCO REGIONAL PARK AND CAVES



The karst complex is one of the largest in Italy, it extends for approximately 35 km, has a vertical depth of -920 m and has four entrances and is located within the Monte Cucco Regional Park.

The Marmore waterfall is formed by the Velino and the Nera, tributaries of the Tevere, near Terni, almost at the mouth of the Valnerina, and is the highest artificial waterfall in Europe.
